Proposed Capital Projects

Abate School was built in 1972. It serves 711 students in grades Pre-K3 – grade 6.

Intended Projects

- Upgrade wiring to CAT 6/6a to ensure optimum compatibility
- Replace Asphalt Play Area (Seal)
- Repair and Replace Plaza/Sidewalk
- New Elevator Cab & Hoist System (3-stop elevator)
- Repair & Seal Concrete Floor & Foundation Walls
- Repair / Replace brick faces plaza bench/kneewalls
- Replace Sliding Wood Door System
- Replace Interior Wooden Door
- Replace Damaged Hardwood Floor
- Replace Sheet Carpeting
- Replace Acoustic Ceiling Tiles
- Replace Athletic Sheet Flooring
- Replace Rubber Stair Treads (Stairs near Stage)
- Replace Wall & Floor Mounted Wood Benches
- Repoint / repair brick masonry exterior walls
- Replace single stainless steel door (pool/shower rm)
- Replace Rubber Stair Treads/Risers - Classroom Stairs
- Replace garage door #23 with man-door and window
- Replace backer rod / sealant at underside of skylights
- Replace center mullion at Door #2 with removable mullion
- Replace wall pads at Multipurpose Rm (second floor)
- Strip and re-seal ceramic floor tile
- Upgrade monumental stair guardrail for safety
- Replace door hardware to match all keying cores

These projects and other capital projects throughout the District,
can only be undertaken
if the referendum passes.
