4th Quarter Report: June 17-28, 2016

- Must include the numbers of hours of instruction completed during the quarter (total for Grades 1 6; by subject for grades 7 12)
- Must include a written description of the materials/topics covered for each subject listed on the IHIP
- A grade or written evaluation of the students progress
- If less than 80% of the instructional plan represented in the IHIP for the quarter has been achieved in any subject, a written explanation is required.

### **Assessment Identification Sheet (enclosed)**

- Must be submitted with your 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarterly Report
- Must identify a norm-referenced standardized achievement test or approved alternative that will be used to document the level of achievement for each student
- Acceptable tests are identified on this sheet. Permission to substitute a test not on that list must be obtained from the NFSCD Home Instruction Director.

## **Annual Assessment Results**

- Results of standardized test identified in the Assessment Identification Sheet must be submitted with your 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Report
- A written narrative may be substituted.
