PS2 is a program designed to help guide students on the best pathway to post-secondary success.

Career exploration activities like **job shadows** and **internships connect the classroom to the real world**, thereby creating relevance for students. The goal is to provide students hands-on opportunities to build career and college readiness skills.

Students can also participate in **dual enrollment**, a program that provides **students the opportunity to complete college-level coursework and earn college credits while enrolled in high school**.

Currently, dual enrollment courses are offered with **Niagara University** (20 courses and more than 300 students earning college credits with NUSTEP), **Niagara County Community College** (23 courses and more than 300 students earning college credits), **Daemen University** (4 courses/8 sections with more than 150 students earning college credits), and **Bryant & Stratton** (1 course /2 sections with 60 students earning college credits.



- Through PS2, the Niagara Falls City School District is partnering with Orleans Niagara BOCES and **Niagara Falls Memorial Medical Center** to **create a pathway for CNA certification and job placement** at Schoellkopf Health Center.
- Niagara Falls High School's Life Skills students are participating in Work Based Learning two days per week with the New York State Parks, Hard Rock Cafe, and the St. James Early Childhood Development Center.
- Dual enrollment courses are aligned with several courses and pathways including, but not limited to: PTech, Junior Law Academy, STEM fields and ESports, as well as the following pathways: Art, Education/Teacher/Social Work, Business Marketing, Computer Science, Criminal Justice and Pre-Law and Hospitality, Sports and Tourism.
- PS2 is collaborating with Buffalo State College for the 2023-2024 school year to add more teacher preparation courses, and to offer college credit for Niagara Falls High School's African American Studies course, as well as a theater course that incorporates Introduction to Theater/History and the African American Experience.
