The student understands that supplies such as grease, rosin, strings, reeds, and oil are to be purchased personally when needed and not by the District. The student agrees to work diligently on this instrument to develop his/her mechanical and musical abilities. The student also agrees to fully participate in the Niagara Falls Public School Music Program. If for any reason the student discontinues the study of this instrument, it is understood that the instrument and accessories will be turned in immediately in acceptable condition.
