Anthony J. Quarantillo II Memorial Scholarship

Mr. Quarantillo was a science teacher at Niagara Falls High School. He began his teaching career in 1964 at LaSalle Senior High School and taught for 46 years in the Niagara Falls School District. He was patient and supportive with a passion for science, educating more than 7,000 students over his career, until his retirement in 2010 at age 74 from Niagara Falls High School. In memory of him and to honor his love for his students, we will award one (1) \$1,000 scholarship to a Niagara Falls High School senior who plans on attending an accredited Community College, College or University to obtain a degree in a science or teaching –related field.
