WHO MAY APPLY:

High school students from Erie County, New York, who are currently enrolled in an engineering program at Buffalo State College or Erie Community College.

Recipient must be accepted for enrollment beginning with the first semester in the fall following graduation from high school. The awardee is selected based on scholastic record, financial need, extracurricular activities and potential leadership capability.

THE ENGINEERING SOCIETY OF BUFFALO, INC. **QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP**

To receive this \$2400.00 cash award, the successful applicant must meet and comply with the following conditions:

1. He/She must be a resident of either Erie or Niagara County in the State of New York and be graduated from a high school in either of these two counties.
2. He/She must be accepted in the School of Engineering at the State University of New York at Buffalo, Buffalo State College or Erie Community College beginning with the first semester of his/her first year in the fall following high school graduation. He/She must be matriculated in an A.B.E.T. accredited engineering program requiring four years of eight full semesters for completion leading to a degree in engineering or technology.
3. He/She will be selected by the Directors of the Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. who will be guided by the recommendations of the Scholarship Committee. This Committee will base its recommendations upon the applicant's past scholastic record, leadership ability, potential, and financial need.
4. He/She must continue with his/her four-year course at SUNY at Buffalo or Buffalo State College without interruption to receive the full amount of the scholarship. However, if after the first semester circumstances should make it impossible for the student to continue their attendance without interruption, the Directors of Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. may consider easing this regulation in order that the spirit of the award be continued. The Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. reserves the right to cancel the scholarship if in any semester the recipient is registered in less than 12 hours of work, if the recipient is not pursuing course work toward a degree in engineering, or if the recipient is on academic probation for two consecutive semesters.
5. Students attending Erie Community College will receive \$1,200 while attending and \$1,200 upon directly continuing two years education at State University of New York at Buffalo or Buffalo State College.
6. When the successful applicant has been certified by the Dean of the School of Engineering of the State of University of New York at Buffalo, Buffalo State College or Erie Community College as matriculated for the fall semester following high school graduation, the Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. will present to him/her the sum of \$300.00. (This is usually at the Past President's Dinner held in October). A like sum will be sent to him/her upon similar certification at the beginning of successive semesters, if he/she complies with paragraph 4, until the total of \$2,400.00 has been paid to this one student.
