WHO MAY APPLY:

High school students from Erie and Niagara Counties who anticipate acceptance in an A.B.E.T www.abet.org engineering or technology program at SUNY Buffalo, Buffalo State College, or Erie Community College.

AWARD:

Four (4) total scholarships awarded each year to matriculated Engineering or Technology students, \$300 per semester – Total \$2400. Recipient must be matriculated the fall semester following graduation from high school. The award is based on scholastic record, finical need, extracurricular activities, and leadership potential.

APPLICATION:

2020 scholarship application to be completed by the student. Scholarship application may be downloaded from our website at www.tesb.org. Older revisions of the application will not be accepted.

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QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE 2020 SCHOLARSHIP

To receive this scholarship, the successful applicant must meet and comply with the following:

- 1. He/She must be a resident of either Erie or Niagara County in the State of New York and be graduated from high school in either of these two counties.
- 2. He/She must be accepted in the School of Engineering at the State University of New York at Buffalo, Buffalo State College, or Erie Community College beginning with the first semester of his/her first year in the fall following high school graduation. He/She must be matriculated in an A.B.E.T www.abet.org accreted engineering/technology program requiring four years of eight full semesters for completion leading to a degree in engineering or technology.
- 3. He/She will be selected by the Directors of the Engineering Society of Buffalo Inc. who will be guided by the recommendations of the Scholarship Committee. The Committee will base its recommendations upon the applicant's past scholastic record, finical need, leadership ability, and potential.
- 4. He/She must continue with his/her four-year course at SUNY at Buffalo or Buffalo State College without interruption to receive the full amount of the scholarship. However, if after the first semester circumstances should make it impossible for the student to continue their attendance without interruption, the Directors of the Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. may consider easing this regulation in order the spirit of the award be continued. The Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. reserves the right to cancel the scholarship if in any semester the recipient is registered in less than 12 hours of work, if the recipient is not pursing course work toward a degree in engineering/technology or if the recipient is on academic probation for two consecutive semesters.
- 5. Student attending **Erie Community College** will receive \$1,200 while attending and \$1,200 upon directly continuing two years education at State University of New York at Buffalo or Buffalo State College.
- 6. When the successful applicant has been certified by the Dean of the School of Engineering at respective schools as matriculated for the fall semester following high school graduation, The Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. will present to him/her the sum of \$300.00 at the Past President's Scholarship Dinner held in October. A like sum will be sent to him/her upon similar certification at the beginning of successive semesters.
