EASY AS 1-2-3

Step 1 – As Soon As Possible

Apply for your **Federal Student Aid ID** (FSA ID) to create a username and password. Both a parent and student must create a **FSA ID**. (This ID serves as your signature on the FAFSA Application) <u>http://fsaid.ed.gov/</u>: then go to the **FSA ID** tab

Step 2 – After October 1st of Senior Year

Early FAFSA available October 1, 2020 for the 2021-2022 college year. Apply for Federal Aid (FAFSA) <u>fafsa.ed.gov</u> (You will need your 2018 Federal Tax Return)

Step 3 – Applying for Student Financial Aid is a two-step process

After submitting the FAFSA, you will be directed to your **CONFIRMATION PAGE**. Click on the New York State Resident link **(HESC)** and apply for State Aid **(TAP)**. This will take you to the NYS Higher Education Website, <u>hesc.ny.gov</u> **(You will need your 2019 NYS Tax Return)**

FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

Apply beginning October 1, 2020 for the 2021-2022 College Academic Year

Apply for a Federal Student Aid ID Number as soon as possible

- Log onto the FAFSA website (<u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u>)
- Go to the FAFSA "FSA ID" site
- Apply for a "FSA ID" number
- Student and one parent must apply for a FSA ID
- Your FSA ID allows you to electronically sign when you submit the FAFSA

Complete the FAFSA Worksheet (optional)

• This worksheet is *optional*; use it to transfer information to the online application

Items Needed to Complete the FAFSA

- At least one parent or guardian
- List of colleges to which you are applying
- Federal Student Aid (FSA ID), your parent's FSA ID
- Social security number
- Parent's social security number and date of birth
- Driver's license number (if you have one)
- Alien registration or permanent resident card (if you are not a U.S. Citizen)
- 2019 Federal and NYS tax returns; W-2's, and other records of money earned (<u>note:</u> <u>You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into you FAFSA using</u> <u>the IRS Data Retrieval Tool</u>)
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)

FAFSA to TAP (NYS Tuition Assistance Program)

 When the FAFSA is submitted, and applicants are at the FAFSA CONFIRMATION PAGE – Go to your state – New York State (HESC.org) and complete the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) application.
