The **NIAGARA FALLS UNIFORMED FIREFIGHTERS LOCAL 714** and **NIAGARA FALLS FIRE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION LOCAL 3359** award a \$1000.00 scholarship to 1 student. The scholarship is open to all Seniors attending Niagara Falls High School or, any family member of the Niagara Falls Fire Department living outside of the Niagara Falls School District. Applicants must have been accepted to an accredited 2 or 4 year college.

Winners will be required to earn **12 Credit Hours** at a College or University by **June** of the following year that the winners graduated from High School.

Winners must receive a minimum of a 2.0 average to receive the award.

If the winner does not fulfill these obligations, the runner up will be awarded the scholarship. If in the event that an unexpected or unforeseen situation were to occur, the Scholarship Committee will be given the power to decide the course of action.

All applications must be returned to the Guidance Office by May 21, 2022.
