Applicants interested in the scholarship award must submit all required documents by October 7, 2024.

The Junior Trailblazer Scholarship Award Recipient will be notified by October 21, 2024.

The Award Recipient will receive their recognition at the Niagara Organizing Alliance for Hope's Gala Saturday, October 26, 2024 @ 5:30 p.m. at the Niagara Falls Country Club 505 Mountain View Drive, Lewiston, NY 14092

The award recipient will receive one ticket to the Gala for themself and one ticket for a guest.

The Scholarship funds will be disbursed in the Fall of 2025 once NOAH receives an Enrollment Form that the student can request from the college after they have enrolled.

Who May Apply? Applicants must meet ALL the following criteria.

- Under-represented High School Senior graduating in the Spring of 2025.
- Currently reside in and attend a high school in Niagara Falls.
- Have at least a "C" average.
- Show evidence of scholastic achievement, leadership abilities, and community service.
- Plan to attend an accredited college or university beginning Fall 2025.

What is Required? Applicants must submit ALL the following items to the Scholarship Committee email address NOAHSCHOLARSHIP@NoahNiagara.org by the submission deadline date of October 7, 2024 with the applicant's name listed on the subject line of all emails.

Essay

- o A 2-page, typed, double spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font essay based on the following topic.
 - What does service mean to you?
 - How do you see yourself serving others now and in the future?
- o Include your full name on each page of the essay.

• Letters of Recommendation

- o Two (2) letters of recommendation.
 - Recommendation form completed by someone at your school who can speak to your current academics (form attached).
 - A personal letter of recommendation from someone who can speak to your character, community involvement, or leadership abilities.
- Your references can send the letters directly to the Scholarship Committee email address with your name listed on the subject line of the email.

• Unofficial School Transcript

O Your unofficial school transcript may be emailed to the Scholarship Committee email address with your name listed on the subject line of the email.

• Zoom Interview

- Finalists in the review process will be asked to participate in a Zoom interview with the Scholarship Committee.
- o Zoom interviews will be scheduled between October 12th and October 20th.
- o Finalists will be contacted to set up the Zoom interview.
