The purpose of this educational award is to give financial assistance to an individual who meets the criteria below and may be used for tuition or fees while continuing their education. The amount of the award is \$500.

Criteria the committee will consider include:

- *Applicant must be a senior or in their last year of school at NFHS at the time of applying.**
- * Applicant must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher**
- *A letter of recommendation must accompany this application from a teacher, counselor, administrator, coach, advisor, manager, supervisor or community leader.**
- * Must complete the application in its entirety. (Including all questions)**
- *Financial need will be taken into consideration.**
- *Must have applied to an accredited University, College, Community College or Trade School. (Must have proof of acceptance before scholarship will be awarded.)**

Fill out page one, applicant may use page provided or use a separate page to answer questions 1-4. Be sure all pages are attached when application is turned in.
