

Hyde Park Elementary School - 3rd Grade Supplies List – 2019 - 2020 School-Year

Dear Parent(s) and/or Guardian(s):

Hello, my name is Mr. Evans and I am going to be your child's 3rd grade teacher this school-year at Hyde Park Elementary. I look forward to meeting and working with your child. This is going to be a challenging year, and one way for students to be successful is to make sure that each of them is prepared at the beginning of the year. I am sending you a list of school supplies that will be needed for the start of the school-year. I will store extra items so that they do not get destroyed or lost before we get a chance to use them.

I will be providing the students with 4 notebooks and 4 folders for the 4 main subjects we will be studying this year. I will also provide them with their first "Take-Home" folder. If they lose or destroy their take home folders, they will be responsible to bring in a new one.

SUPPLIES:

- Pencils – **2 or 4** packages of #2 lead (**Yellow pencils please – no plastic coated pencils**)
- Zippered Pencil Bag – We use cloth bags because they are easier to store, don't open up when they hit the floor, and they USUALLY don't break.
- **1** bottle hand sanitizer or package or tub of wet wipes (baby wipes)
- Tissue - **2 to 4** boxes – to be used by the whole class. These will come in handy during cold and allergy seasons, and they will go fast.
- **1** pkg. Erasers –(Pencil cap erasers are the best-available at Dollar Tree)
Pencils, tissue and hand sanitizer will be stored to be used throughout the year.

Things we **DO NOT** need:

- **Make-Up, Purses, Perfume, Cologne** – This is school, we are here to learn, these items are distractions and some students have been known to have reactions to certain fragrances. (Deodorant is Acceptable)
- **TOYS** – The students will be told at the beginning of the year that NO TOYS ARE ALLOWED. If a toy is in the classroom and it is confiscated, it will be held until June 2020.
- **Phone or other electronic devices** – Use or possession of a phone by a student during the school day is against the "Code of Conduct". The phone will be confiscated and will be returned to a parent from the office. Other devices will be considered TOYS and will be held until the end of the school-year. If a phone must be brought to school it will be placed in my desk until the end of the day.
