Abate Parent Group Meeting Minutes January 10, 2019, 5:30pm

Becky Hedgepeth welcomed everyone and read the minutes from the December meeting. She also reviewed the charter, voting procedures and necessary volunteer sheet for newcomers.

The Parent Group distributed January newsletters to staff mailboxes.

Paul Hedgepeth would look out for Fidelis Care potential donation of \$400.
Becky would check on the status of last year's decorations.
Becky would recruit volunteers and contact volunteers from last year.

We discussed the possibility of hosting a family movie night later in the year.

Paul Hedgepeth gave a financial update. The balance was \$1,668.90. We voted to approve reimbursing all expenses related to the staff break room remodel (approx. \$400), as well as some misc. expenses for staff Christmas treats and the canned food drive winning class pizza party as soon as receipts were collected.

We discussed an Abate Garden Club to work on beautifying out school's exterior. Jennifer O'Conner would reach out to Grass Roots Gardens, Ms. Gawron, Tracy Vincent, and possibly

others, to form a committee and meet in February to discuss ideas and possibilities. Mrs. Tompkins would inform the district of the school's desire to incorporate the garden in summer school curriculum. Also, the April parent group meeting would be a family planting activity night.
