## **Advanced Placement COVID-19 Updates**

April 3, 2020

All Niagara Falls High School students enrolled in an Advanced Placement class are encouraged to take the exam this spring despite the current school closure. Below is a summary of the latest updates from the College Board regarding AP Courses and Exams for this spring including the **revised testing schedule**.

### **General Testing Information**

- Exams will be given from May 11 through May 22 (see schedule below).
- AP Exams will be open book/open note.
- Exams will be taken online from home.
- Students will be able to take exams on any device they have access to—computer, tablet, or smartphone. They will be able to either type and upload their responses or write responses by hand and submit a photo via their cell phone.
- In late April, The College Board will provide AP students and educators with information on how to access the testing system on test day, and video demonstrations so that students can familiarize themselves with the system.
- Students who have previously been approved by College Board will be able to take online AP Exams with College Board—approved accommodations such as extended time. Details will be available soon.
