CURRENT ISSUE ANALYSIS

local, state, national political interest. Be sure to explain the level of "citizen participation" (if

any) that has characterized the process of "public policy development."

- 1. Describe in detail the issue affecting society (state in the form of a question). Be sure to use relevant factual information from the articles.
- 2. Describe the public policy that was developed (or proposed) to address the issue. Examine any competing public policy proposals that have been offered
- 3. Explain in detail at least **one** major effect on society that has occurred (or will occur) as a result of any government involvement regarding this issue. You must clearly demonstrate the cause-effect relationship that exists.
- 4. Describe one specific consequence that has affected (or will affect) the individual citizen as a result of any government involvement in this issue [how has the individual's life been changed?].
- 5. Describe the level of "citizen participation" that occurred in the development of public policy regarding this issue. If there was little or no citizen participation, explain the reasons why.
- 6. In your opinion, how should citizens become involved in the development of public policy regarding this issue?

ECONOMIC ISSUE ANALYSIS

Directions – Using a newspaper, magazine article, Internet source, or any other government

or business document, **AND** additional outside information, analyze a current economic issue that has local, state, national, or international significance. Be sure to answer the following questions directly, make certain to distinguish between "causes" and "effects."

1. Describe in detail the economic trend that is currently affecting society or is predicted to soon be affecting society. Is this condition local, regional, national, or
