Our Schedule is Changing! Details are here!!

Elementary Hybrid Students to attend 4 days a week starting Monday, April 26, 2021

Our Superintendent, Mr. Laurrie has announced, on All Calls and at a Town Hall Meeting on Tuesday night, the changing social distancing guidance which enables Elementary students to return to school four days a week. (You can watch the meeting on www.nfschools.net under the Superintendent's Video Updates Tab.) We are very excited to have our students together!

What does this mean *exactly*?

1. **All Hybrid Students** in Pre-K to Grade Six are to attend school in person on **Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays**. Students are no longer attending just on "Blue" or "Gold" days.
2. **All Hybrid Students** in Kindergarten to Grade Six are to attend **live class on-line** with their teacher(s) **on Wednesdays** from home.
3. This **starts** on Monday, **April 26, 2021**.
4. School arrival and dismissal times are unchanged.
5. Transportation will be rolled over "as is" for all students who ride the bus.
6. We will still wear masks.
7. We will keep a distance of 3 ft. wearing masks in class and keep 6 ft. apart when eating, drinking, singing, playing instruments and during PE class.
8. Remote students will remain in Remote classes, no change to program.
9. As always, we ask that students who are not feeling well stay home from school.
