High Frequency Words

The following list of words are words most frequently used in reading. Practice the words with your child one list at a time. Work on List 1 words, then continue with the following list. Suggestion: write words on index cards/pieces of paper (one word per index card/paper) and make two piles as your child says the word, one pile for words they know and the other for words to work on. (For example; Work on words are words that take your child more than 5-7 seconds.) Move on to the next list once your child know the majority of the words from the list. A suggestion activity, after the list of words are well known is play Tic-Tac-Toe. Write a word in each section. Mark the spot when word is read correctly.
