Remember these spelling rules:

If a word ends in "e":

Drop the "e" before adding –ing or –ed **Example: dive turns into diving or dived**

If a verb has a short vowel sound and ends with a consonant: double the final consonant before adding –ed or –ing

Example: stop turns into stopping or stopped

If a noun ends in consonant and "y":

Change "y" to i and add –es **Example: story turns into stories**

If a noun ends in a vowel and "y": keep the "y" and just add -s

Example: toy turns into toys

More Spelling Rules to remember:

If a word ends in -f or -fe:

Change the –f or –fe to "v" and add –es

Example: wife turns into wives

If a word ends in -s, -ss, --x, -sh, -ch, -tch: Instead of adding just -s, you need to add -es

Examples:

class turns into classes box turns into boxes dish turns into dishes church turns into churches patch turns into patches
