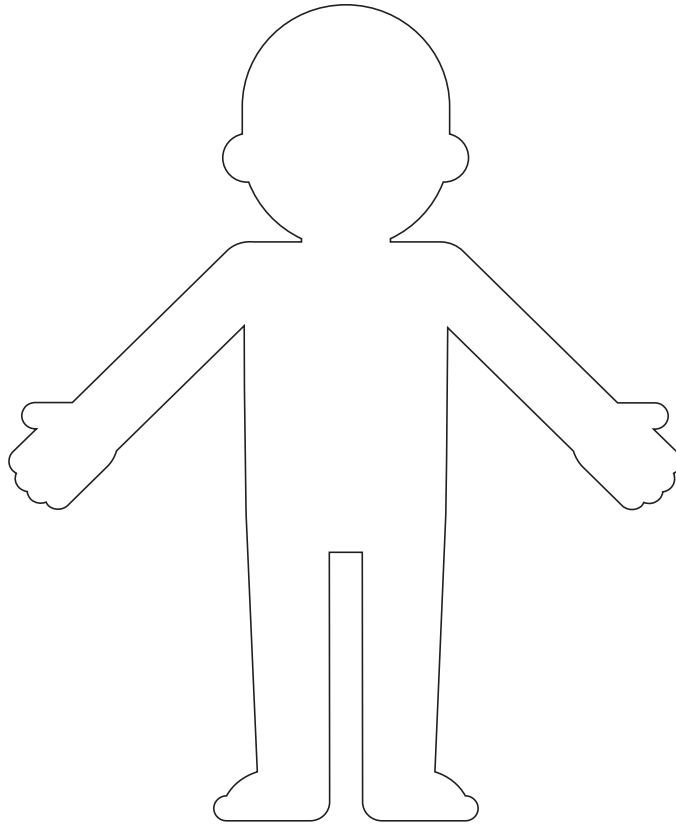


## Lesson 1 - What's the Weather like Today?

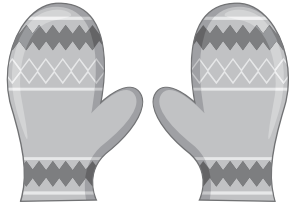
