We believe in student-centered learning and recognize that students must continue to learn to work together and think critically to solve problems in order to be successful in this technologically advanced society.

Our school-wide goals will include maintaining a school environment that supports:

- a student-centered instructional focus with high levels of student engagement

The Niagara Falls City School District's first priority is to keep our students and staff safe through our layered security approach at all our schools. Keeping safety and security in mind, we have updated the Visitor's Policy, as follows:

Anyone entering a school must be prepared to present a Driver's License or Government Identification and be checked in utilizing the Raptor Visitor Management System. Before visiting the

school, please call the school's main telephone number and make an appointment for your visit. If you just need to leave something for a student, there will be a space provided for you to do that without entering the school. Once a visitor clears security, they are to go directly to their named location.

We have been very productive this summer preparing for our student's safe return. New procedures and policies have been established in regards to student and staff health, wellness and safety while adhering to all NYS guidelines (subject to change).

Many of our teachers engaged in professional development on student engagement, checking for understanding, and in ELA, Science, Social Studies and Math to study the core curriculum standards to address the lingering learning gaps due to the Pandemic. Our School Comprehensive Educational Plan (SCEP) Committee met to plan for school-wide initiatives to include: Academic Achievement, Instructional Programming and Building a Positive School Culture while supporting Social Emotional Learning. Our Trauma Informed Care (TIC) Champion team will continue to implement a task force to support the social emotional wellness of our students to include Trusted Adult Mentors for our students in need.

Important note on monitoring student health: As always, student daily attendance will continue to be a priority. I would like to thank you in advance for your support in monitoring your child(ren's) health prior to them leaving for school. As we have done in the recent past, we ask that you do not send your child(ren) to school if they are unwell or experiencing COVID-like symptoms. Your child's teacher will work with you to offer support while they are absent.
