Know that a key factor in maintaining our path to improvement is student attendance. Last year, half

of our students were chronically absent from school. Common sense indicates that your child has to be here to reach his or her full potential. When a student misses 10% or more of the school year (18 days), which is only 2 days a month, they are chronically absent. Our data shows that students with good attendance out perform students with poor attendance on every measure. Please make every effort to have your child at school every day. It is the best way to insure their continued success in prep school and beyond (See below...).

Have you checked on your child's grades lately? The

Parent Portal at www.nfschools.net allows you real time access to your **child's grades**. Now is a good time to look, as by March 1st, parents of students who are being considered for non-promotion (repeating their current grade) will be receive a phone call, written notification and a request for a parent conference from the school.

The Presidents' Day Holiday will be celebrated with no school on Monday, February 17th.

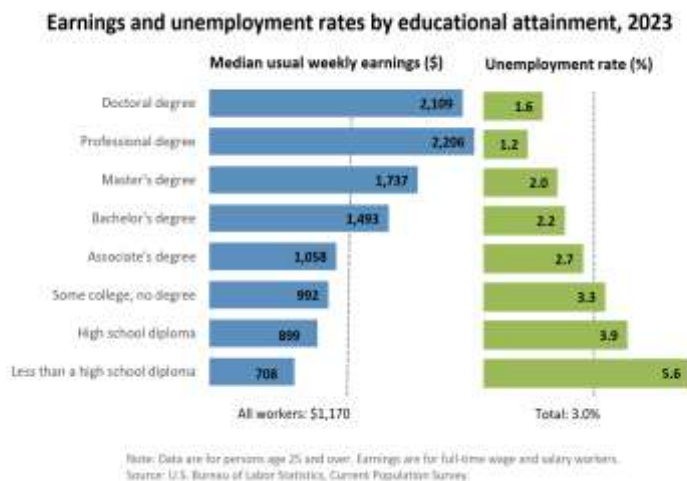
