- To connect families with resources outside of the school District that address needs other than educational
- ✤ To monitor each child's progress, and report that information to the child's family in a timely manor
- ✤ To differentiate instructional strategies, schedules and learner outcomes to meet the needs of each child
- ✤ To celebrate the successes of each child as he progress through the milestones of early childhood Development
