



Pre- K Teacher Training

All Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 teachers not only have their Bachelor's and Master's Degrees, they have received job-embedded training in the following areas:

- Teaching Strategies/Creative Curriculum (Core Curriculum)
- Teaching Strategies/Creative Curriculum Gold (Authentic Assessment)
- Teaching Strategies/Creative Curriculum Cloud (Online Component)
- Teaching Strategies/Creative Curriculum continued Instructional Coaching support
- Early Childhood Environmental Rating Scale - ECERS (Classroom Environment and set-up)
- Pyramid Model Training (Social Emotional and Behavioral Training)
- Basic Emotional Skills Program (B.E.S.T. - Social Emotional Learning Training)
- All elementary music teachers have completed training sessions in the Kindermusic Program. Pre-K students receive music instruction from the District's certified music teachers in addition to the music activities that the classroom teacher provides.
- All Pre-K 3, Pre-K 4, and elementary art teachers have completed training sessions in Open-Ended Art training. Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 students receive art instruction from the District's certified art teachers in addition to the art activities that the classroom teacher provides.
- All elementary physical education teachers have completed training sessions in early childhood gross motor activities. Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 students receive physical education instruction from the District's certified physical education teachers in addition to the activities that the classroom teacher provides.
