Prompt: # 10 Design a special Cup or Mug!

Before we abruptly left, we were going to create a sgrafito design carved mug using colored clay slips known as underglazes. There's so much more to look at online if you need more inspiration, create a design for a mug you would want to be your own special mug, or a gift for someone special!



Prompt: # 11 Easy Clay/Play Dough Recipe

Ingredients 1 cup flour. 2 tsp cream of tartar. 1/2 cup salt. 1 tbsp cooking oil. 1 cup water.food coloring.

Instructions: In a large bowl, combine all of your dry ingredients (flour, salt, cream of tartar) and mix well. Mix food coloring with your water first. Then add the vegetable oil and water with food coloring to a large pot. Mix together. Add the dry ingredients to your pot and mix well. Cook over low to medium heat until the dough starts to form and becomes dry. Once it starts to form a ball together and looks fully cooked, take off the heat. Let the dough cool first before touching. Once cool, knead the dough for 5 minutes to make the dough soft. Then practice working with clay! Take a picture of what you create or draw a picture!
