



Tom was as the Music Director, Arranger and Studio Musician for two CD recordings, My Father's Hymns and Broadway and Beyond, by local artist Lee Stevens. In January of 2023, Tom performed at 54 Below in New York City as a pianist for a special engagement of the Stage Door Medium with Jimmy Moses. DENNIS WILSON (Director) was born and raised in Niagara Falls, NY. He attended Niagara University where he earned a BFA in Theatre Arts and a Med in Education Administration from Grand Canyon University. Upon graduation from Niagara University, Dennis became heavily involved in community theatre in Buffalo, NY. He relocated to New York City in 1995 and was immediately cast in theatrical productions. The next few years Dennis engaged in a professional acting career. He was blessed to be able to become a member of The Actor's Equity Association (AEA). Dennis has performed in the National and Canadian Touring Companies of *Five Guys Named Moe* (Little). Regional credits include: Once On This Island (Papa Ge), Toys in the Attic (Gus), Ain't Misbehavin (Andre), The Zoo Story (Peter), A Chorus Line (Mike & Bobby), Cabaret (Kit Kat Girl), West Side Story (Luis), Dutchman (Clay), Jesus Christ Superstar (Judas), Hair (Tribe Member), Smokey Joe's Café. Dennis is an accomplished choreographer, having staged productions of Sophisticated Ladies, Ragtime, The Wiz, Cabaret, West Side Story, The King and I, Smokey Joe's Café and Jesus Christ Superstar. In 2005, Dennis founded a theatrical production company, Dendewil Productions. Dennis also humbly adds the title of author to his credits having written and self-

published three books, My Void My Voice (Poetry 2012), Eros Dennis (Poetry 2013), Morning Coffee Thoughts (Positive Affirmations 2016). Dennis wrote, produced and directed his first web series. The Therapist, which had its premiere in October 2021 on YouTube. During the summer of 2022, Dennis recorded an audio version of his poetry from his publication, My Void My Voice. Most recently, Dennis appeared as the Apparition in an original Regional-World Premiere of The Magnolia Ballet at the Alleyway Theatre in Buffalo, NY. Dennis currently resides in Niagara Falls and teaches theatre at Niagara Falls High School.

A MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

Good evening and welcome to the Niagara Proscenium Players production of *The Diary of Anne Frank.* Anne Frank and her family went into hiding for two years in Amsterdam, while World War II ravished Germany and the Nazis set a course of destruction and persecution of Jewish people. The Frank Family as well as The Van Pels (Van Daan) Family (Hermann, Auguste and son Peter) and Fritz Pfeffer (Mr. Dussell), went into hiding in an Annex above a store until they were eventually found and sent to concentration camps where they would experience unimaginable horror. The Holocaust is one of the most atrocious events to occur in world history and will forever leave an unhealed wound in the spirit of mankind. Anne's story has had a huge impact on the world and humanity ever since her diary was discovered and published. Anne kept a diary detailing life as they hid away in an attic. This all happened as Anne was growing from a young girl into her teenage years. The spirit of this beautiful young lady continues to inspire us all 79 years after her death.

As a director, I have a passion for telling stories about the human spirit and how we thrive as we endure the many ups and downs of life. Anne's story is definitely a story that I have always wanted to tell. Her ability to remain so positive while living in a world of hate, fear and hiding is the most beautiful and tragic tale I have ever come across. Anne did have her moments of frustration. Her final diary entry reads: "When everybody starts hovering over me, I get cross, then sad, and finally end up turning my heart inside out, the bad part on the outside and the good part on the inside and keep trying to find a way to become what I'd like to be and what I could be if...if only there were no other people in the world". While reading the script and researching Anne's life and ordeal, it became very apparent to me that there is an Anne in all of us. It's scary to think that in the blink of an eye, what happened to Anne and 8 million other human beings could happen again to any of us.

For me, this play is important on so many levels. As an educator, I believe that it is important for our students to learn about the past. Learning about the great things of the past will help us to grow and prosper. Learning about the bad things of the past will help us to never repeat it. As an artist, I feel that *The Diary of Anne Frank* is an excellent play for a group of actors to totally engross themselves in as they hone their talent and skill sets.
