### TAKE NOTES

When you **take notes**, you record a text’s main ideas and key information in a way that is easy to understand and remember. Since text features highlight main ideas and key information, including them in your notes can help. You can write notes using phrases or sentences. You can also use graphic aids to help you organize your notes.
